We are again planning a trip for the Senior Class to Washington, D.C. in the Spring. This annual trip has been one of the high points of the Senior Year and we hope this trip will be as successful and enjoyable as in recent years.

Specific information about the itinerary and costs will be mailed to you sometime during the month of September. On the trip, students will visit the Smithsonian Museums, the major memorials (Vietnam, World War II, Iwo Jima, Korean War, Lincoln, Jefferson and Roosevelt) and Arlington National Cemetery. They will attend a play at the Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts, experience Sunday Liturgy at the National Basilica of the Immaculate Conception, explore the architecture of the Washington National Cathedral, participate in dinner theater at Medieval Times, and enjoy a dinner dance cruise on the Potomac. We will tour the Naval Academy in Annapolis and have the opportunity to visit the harbor area in both Annapolis and Baltimore. While in Baltimore, we will take a Duck Tour of the City, seeing some of the many interesting aspects of Baltimore as well as splashing down in the Inner Harbor. A sporting event is scheduled based on availability.

The following dates will help you plan ahead:

October 15, 2009 - Initial Deposit of \$250 due

December 15, 2009 - One half of the remaining balance due

February 15, 2010 - Last half of the remaining balance due

Monday, March 15, Tuesday, March 16 and Wednesday, March 17, 2010 - Parent pre-trip meetings. (At least one parent must attend one of the meetings. Three meeting dates are scheduled to provide some options for you.)
